2. International Judo-Tournament of the Heilpädagogisches Centrum Augustinum and the Sportfreunde Hardeck München for Judoka with a

mental handicap (G-Judo)

- Participants:** Judoka with mental handicap (women/men) of all ages with valid sport health certificate (at the most 6 month old / see protection regulations)
The competition takes place in three performance classes
Performance class 1: Judoka with more easily handicap, which could train with non-handicapped.
Performance class 2: Judoka with heavy handicaps, which train in homogeneous groups of obstructions.
Performance class 3: Judokas with heaviest handicaps, which accomplish judo only as play form.
- Minimum graduation: 8. Kyu (white-yellow belt); white belt after consultation on own responsibility possible
- Weight categories / Age categories:** The athletes will be sorted into homogeneous competition-groups.
- To provide each athlete at least three fights the tournament-director may summarize different age categories as well as male and female judoka to one competition-group (after consultation with the responsible person/coach).
If necessary also a common pool with physically handicapped athletes is possible.
- Referees:** will be nominated by BJV (Bavarian Judo Federation)

- Number of mattes:** up to 4 (depending to the number of participants)
- Mode:** pool system
Prohibition of all lever (Arm locks/Kantsetsu-waza) and choking (Shime-waza) techniques and of Ryo Ashi Dori.
Performance class 1: The time of a match is 3 minutes effectively.
The fights begin in standing position and resumed in standing position after an interruption.
Penalties are only warned at first and expressed in the instance of repetition (Exception: Endangerment the own health or that of the opponent)
Performance class 2: The time of a match is 2 minutes effectively.
The fights begin in standing position. The desire of an athlete is sufficient to begin the fight in the soil (ne-waza).
Penalties are not expressed (Exception: Endangerment the own health or that of the opponent)
Performance class 3: The time of a match is 2 minutes effectively.
Interruptions are possible at any time. The needs of the athletes have absolute priority.
Penalties are not expressed (Exception: Endangerment the own health or that of the opponent)
